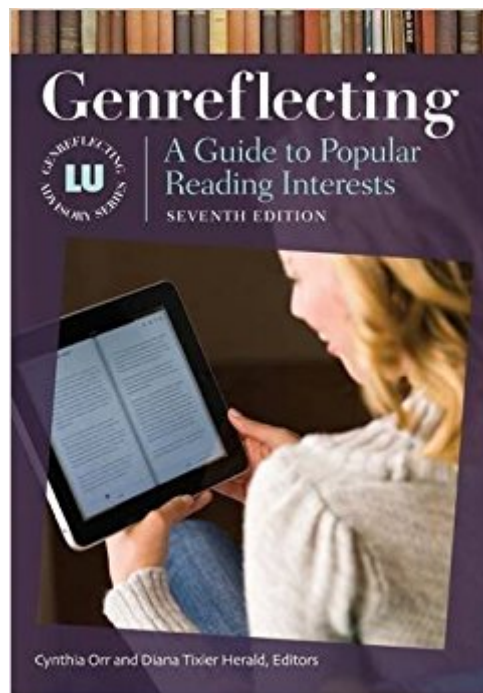




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Genreflecting: A Guide To Popular Reading Interests, 7th Edition (Genreflecting Advisory Series)
