

The information about city attractions is extremely poor! The book describes only several main attractions in very boring way, it is impossible to read it through and remember something about it. I expect something more exciting than just dry chronological description. To me this book was totally useless, I didn't find anything interesting or new. Finally I had to read some info simply from Wikipedia.

Layout of guide easy to follow but some of the information turned out to be out of date when I visited so I wasted time going to places that were not open on a Monday. I found it useful to sort through options about what might interest me ahead of my visit and what was likely to be achievable in the time I had available

Although it does cover a few highlights of Milan, I had expected it to be much more extensive. In the end it only describes a few highlights and not so much info is given. If this were a booklet it would be very thin indeed.

My trip to Milan would be for 2 days and 1 night, and I'm definitely taking the 4 pages brochure with me.
