

I used this book in my 300-level German class to replace the outdated "Deutsche Wirtschaftssprache fÃr Amerikaner." After using "GeschÃftsdeutsch," I much prefer it. Each chapter focuses on a set topic in the business world, such as writing a business letter in German. It gives many examples of business letters and even explains the layout--right down to how many spaces go in between sections of the letter and the complexity of German titles. The EU is explained in detail so that a non-EU citizen will get a good feeling of it in the German language. Vocabulary lists for German to English are also included. There is even a section on how to write a resume and the format of it that German companies prefer. Instead of just learning vocabulary, students will also learn about the culture of German-speaking lands and how that relates to business. For any German professors out there needing a new textbook for your "Business German" classes, this one is the best I've found.

I can't believe a college level textbook would NOT have put the vocabulary in the glossary in the same order that a German dictionary would!!! For example, all the reflexive verbs were put under S!!!!!! The same with with the idioms!!!! To me this is a mess. To make matters worse, the person who typed this left a huge space between the German word and the translation, effectively leaving no room to write in other words that each learner would need to do for their individual glossary. Everyone does not encounter the same vocabulary when learning a foreign language. It's better to provide MORE vocabulary, not less. Otherwise, why buy a book when there are literally hundreds of millions of text pages on the Internet to look up. Books should be written for the learners NOT for the typists or writers who may wish to express themselves in quirky ways!!!!
