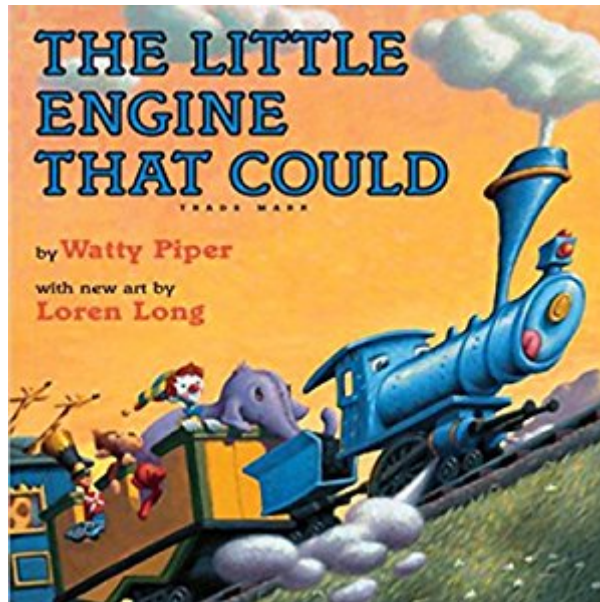

Great story but the product description needs work. This book was so small, when I opened my package I almost mistook it for an advertisement thrown in with the order. It's literally the size of a thinner CD case, not the thicker case normally seen with music CD's for those of you that still buy those. Also, this book is the "Abridged Edition", which is in the picture but unless you were looking for it specifically, it's too small to notice. Not sure why you'd want an abridged version of this book, it's a children's book, how much shorter do you need it to be? If you want a travel size book that isn't very bulky or heavy, then this is the book for you. If you want something large enough to read to your child and see large pictures, look for a normal sized book.

I didn't realize this is a mini booklet, when I ordered it I thought it was the regular sized book, but other than that it is very interesting, my 4 and 6 year old boys love it

My mom used to read me this when I was very young. And, I think that phrase "I think I can, I know I can" has followed me throughout my years. A wonderful lesson to learn at a young age.
