

I liked that the states were listed alphabetically in the index because my one complaint would be the states being grouped into weird groups, making it difficult to find the states immediately. Everytime our lesson referred to a state, we'd quickly cover that state-the capital, the state flower and bird, Their products, National Parks, Native American Reservations and anything else my student wanted to discuss. For instance, one book we were reading was about the Wright Brothers so we looked at Ohio and North Carolina.
