

The chapters are broken up into themes, with an entry from both the mother and father of Rachel. It is interesting to read two perspectives on the same issue, and their different reactions to Rachel's journals. The highlight of the book, is Rachel's own entries, she is a normal girl who had problems and temptations yet found a health release and alternative in writing to god in her journal. These journals ended up helping her parents to come to terms with their grief and to be happy they had their daughter for the short time they did. This book will make you re-evaluate your life, your relationships and priorities. A brilliant book!
