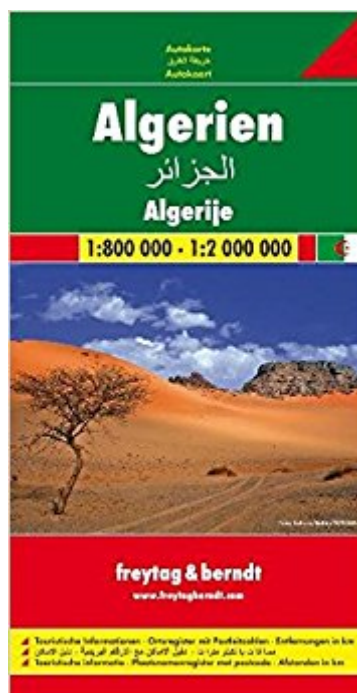


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Algeria

Explore Algeria with this Freytag&Berndt road map. The best way to plan your trip, prepare your itinerary, and to travel independently in this country. One side shows Northern Algeria at a scale of 1cm=8km. The other side shows the rest of the country â “from Ghardaia to the Niger/Mali bordersâ “ at a scale of 1cm=20km. This map contains a place name index in a booklet; touristic information: airports, places of interest, archaeological sites, ruins, religious buildings, oil-fields, spas, wells, The legend is in English, Arabic, French, German, Italian, Spanish, Dutch, Czech, Hungarian, and Slovak. All place names are indicated in Roman script.

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
