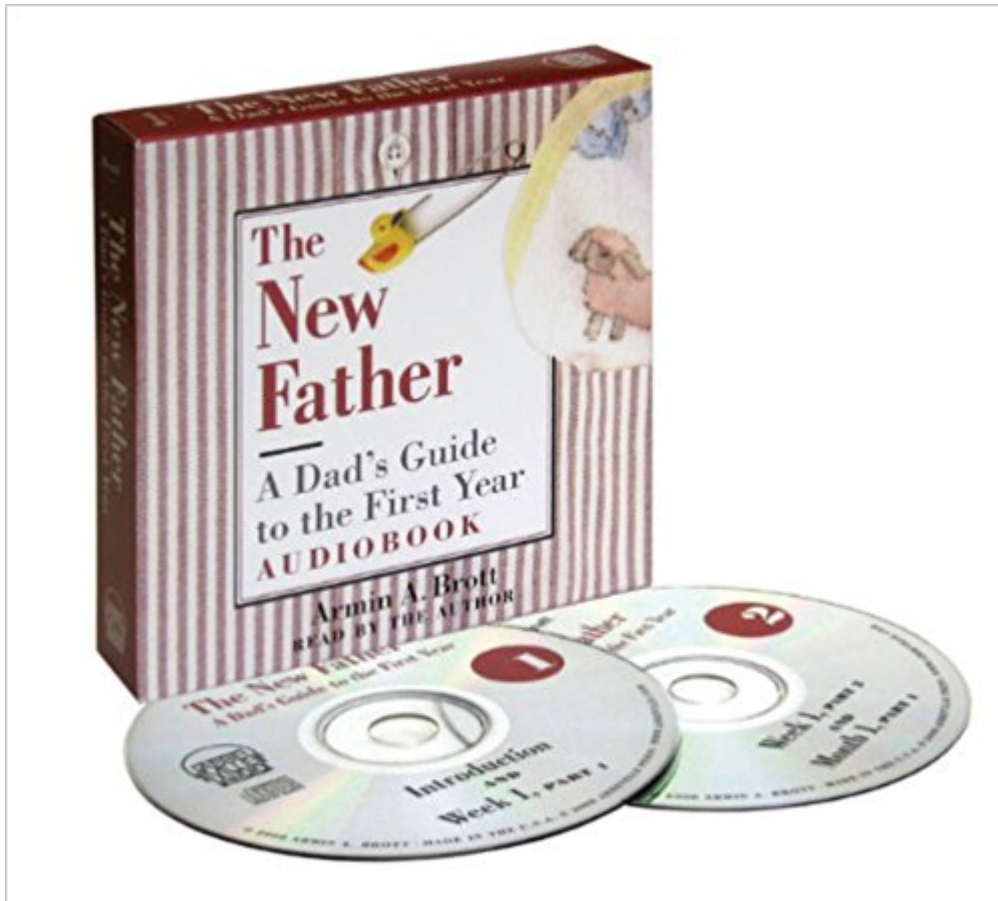

How can you become an effective, involved father when you see your baby only briefly after work? What is the best way to start saving for your child's college education? with advice for divorced and renewed dads. The resources section and bibliography are considerably expanded. Illustrated throughout with New Yorker-style cartoons that underscore the joys and woes of parenting, *The New Father* is an essential sourcebook for every dad.
