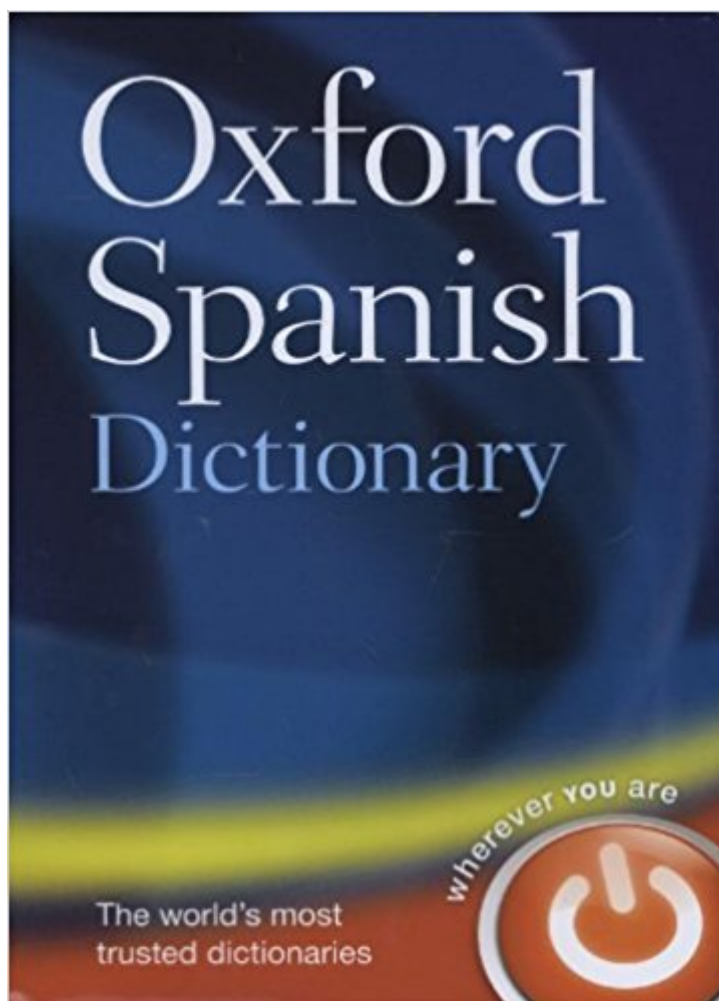

When the subject is language arts and the English language is involved, the source for information is Oxford University Press. This is my second Oxford Spanish/English Dictionary, replacing a 20-year-old edition that, along with my Oxford Concise English Dictionary and Fowler’s Modern English Usage, has served well over the years. Daily use has resulted in physical deterioration of the older editions along with inevitable changes in language dictated the need to semi-retire them to reference emeritus shelf. The new editions are all that I expected.

Great publication... shopped around for awhile before deciding on this one, one for the desk, not the pocket, comprehensive writing vocabulary.

What’s not to love about this dictionary? It’s chock full of all kinds of words. If all you have is a Bantam Spanish-English paperback dictionary or something like that you will need to supplement with a larger more complete dictionary for day-to-day use. And yes, 33\$ is a lot to pay in this day and age where electronic information makes print media redundant. However, I like to have the actual book itself from time to time. And you will find it a good investment, because you will use it year after year. It has all kinds of slang and culinary references. For example: chupi = great chupin = fish stew The English section is quite a bit larger than the Spanish section, though the Spanish section is quite large. The entry words are in blue, while the definitions are in black. Pretty easy to read. Paper quality is actually a little on the thin side, but not ridiculously so. Overall, an excellent reference work.

This is an excellent, comprehensive dictionary. It is easy to read and it’s full of illustrative examples

of idiomatic usage. It also contains numerous additional resources for various purposes, e.g., formal and informal correspondence, use of the telephone, text messaging, and e-mail. It's an excellent reference tool--the next best thing to an unabridged dictionary.

The coverage is better than the Diccionario Esencial and the examples in the Oxford are excellent. I particularly appreciate how it does not even attempt to provide an English equivalent for many Spanish terms but rather provides extensive examples, with translation, for how they may be used. I have been recently been reading 19 century short stories in Spanish and this dictionary has been a godsend for find many of the more obscure or colloquial terms.
