

I purchased this for my four year old and he loves it! Sixty pages of fun and every page is engaging in its own way. I love that they added a chart in the back where he can add a sticker each time he completes a page and watch the progress (it comes with gold stars to add to the pages as he completes them). Overall, a perfect learning book for the little one, and the size is not overwhelming for him.

This book is a fantastic introduction to letter sounds and reading. I first bought a copy to work with our son on recognizing letter sounds. I'm back now to buy additional copies for when our younger kids are ready to start school. Before we started this book, our son had no experience at all with recognizing letter sounds. Just a few months later, after going through all of the lessons, he is sounding out entire words on his own. Most lessons are a collection of pictures with the instruction to circle the one that begins with a certain letter sound (or has the sound in the middle, when you get to vowels). Later, there are also words to circle, or words to complete with missing letters. The best way I found to go through the lessons, since some pictures could be multiple things (tub vs bath) has been to say each word for him and ask if he hears the letter sound. It is definitely an introduction book. It only covers one sound for each letter, and does not go into any blends like "ch" or "th". However, as a simple step-by-step walk through of the basic idea of letter sounds, it is exactly what we needed to get the reading ball rolling.

As a former preschool, kindergarten and elementary teacher, and reading consultant to high need schools, I recommend this phonics workbook for enrichment for children to do during the summer or when not at school. It has a variety of activities involving phonics and short vowel words, beginning sounds etc. I also like the Primary Phonics workbooks and readers once your child is sounding out short vowel words like cat, bug, dog, pig, bed etc.

I got this for my 3 year old to practice writing since she already knew all of her letters and their sounds. I was trying to stick to one to two pages at a time not to overwhelm her but she asks for more. Well laid out and obviously fun for my 3 year old. Would recommend.

I am a retired teacher and I have a third grader I'm tutoring in reading. He isn't dyslexic, but has similar problems. He is extremely intelligent and the effect of his not being able to read very well has impaired his self-esteem & confidence in life. His reading skills are so low that I decided to go back to the kindergarten level and start from the beginning in order to find the glitch in his reading ability.

This book is perfect! It takes one letter at a time and reinforces the sound of the letter through pictures (circling, drawing lines, etc), then moves on to the next letter. After that, letter combinations are introduced (th, sh, cl, etc) and then double vowels (oa, ea, oi, etc). I like this book so much that I am back at looking for a first grade phonetic book to continue his learning. If your child needs to learn the letters and their sounds and to see what letters look like, this is the book for you!

This book is incredible! My son is 5 and in special education (diagnosed with "Autistic-like symptoms at 3), and he's a little slower to develop than most children his age. His attention span and focus isn't great, so I've been looking for at home activities to do with him especially in the area of reading and writing to help him along. I ordered this a couple weeks ago and we are already almost done! This book has helped him IMMENSELY (along with a couple other activities) to the point where I read him the directions, can leave the room, and he finishes the activities by himself! He's only in TK and his teacher says he is already reading at kindergarten level. We do other activities at home along with this book, but I do highly recommend this to any parent who wants their child to have a bit of extra practice or might be lacking in this particular department in their education. This book is great, I will be purchasing more from this publisher!

Very simple exercises to help a child that can't quite read yet learn to focus on the sounds each letter makes and to hear those sounds in the words they use every day. My toddler loves that it came with gold stars for her to earn by completing each page. On the first day she received the book she did 20 pages of her own freewill.

Perfect. This was exactly what I needed. An easy workbook for my son to practice what he has learned in kindergarten while off for summer vacation. He loved putting the stickers on the back as he completed each lesson.

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
