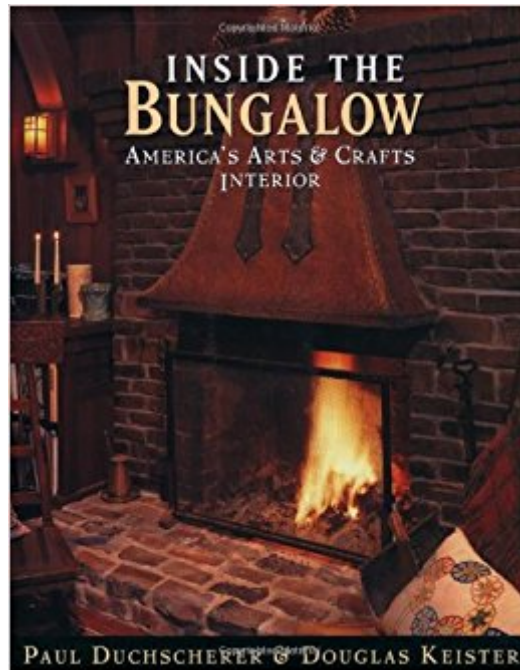

Even in its most ornate manifestation, Arts and Crafts/Craftsman styles can be replicated by the hobbyist/DIYer with a modicum of equipment. It's a great book if you just like to look at pictures of the style of the time. Oh, by the way, there is good history in there too for the pure academician.

This book is terrific if you are interested in bungalow home furniture. The furniture is lovely and many arts and crafts styles are shown. The pictures are excellent and I first saw this book in the Bungalow section of the Oakland Museum in Oakland, CA. I cannot recommend it highly enough. The book is exceptional in that the homes range from the 1930's to present day so you can see classic and contemporary versions.

Starting with the significance of the front door, this book examines all the traditional features of craftsman bungalow. The love and care of the homeowners is on display with the choice of fixtures, art objects, window treatments and rugs.

The writing in the book is a little prosaic and doesn't add a ton, but the pictures are really inspiring. Almost of the images are of careful restorations that brought rooms back to their original style. It's a little over the top, but for someone planning a renovation or interested in these houses, it's nice to really understand the original intent of the arts and crafts movement.

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
