

I have a real passion about scuba diving, and a need to feel CONFIDENT about reading a book on wrecks in the New Jersey area, Long Island area, or any region for that matter. Wreck diving as a subject can be approached in various angles. First, it can be as a technical view. Talk about the gear, talk about the debth of the dive, the currents, the location of the dive in respect to the shore, and talk about the selection of gasses. All the technical aspects of the wreck dive. Second, it can be

discussed from an experience view, as one scuba diver to another. What was interesting in this wreck over another wreck. What was the dive plan used, who were the dive buddies, and what did you do the night before the dive. Did you have sandwiches on board the boat. The third aspect could be the history of the wrecks.
