

I purchase this eBook to get some ideas on how to grow more fruits and vegetables in my small yard. I was so impressed with the many great ideas. I especially liked the WikiGrow System because it is easy and looks fun. My other favorite one was the Rain Tower. I hope to try and build one this spring. I highly recommend this book if you enjoy gardening.

The book presented some great ideas for making your yard more productive. However, the poor editing took a lot away from the book for me. There were numerous grammatical errors and misspellings--the first one being the first word of the second sentence of the book--it is drought, not draught. My word, how can an "editor" not catch that? There are broken or missing links throughout. You are told to use a keyhole saw when they mean a hole saw--lots of difference. A hole saw is a drill bit meant for drilling holes. A keyhole saw is a small hand held saw with a long narrow blade. I have never understood people who take the time and effort to write a book (and this book has great information), but don't care enough to get a real editor. Gregg Stephens, you should be ashamed of yourself, calling yourself an editor!Marcelina, I look forward to your book on herbs, but, please care enough about your work to get it edited by a proper editor.

This book is very thorough and gives you all of the tools necessary to grow your own food. I definitely recommend.
