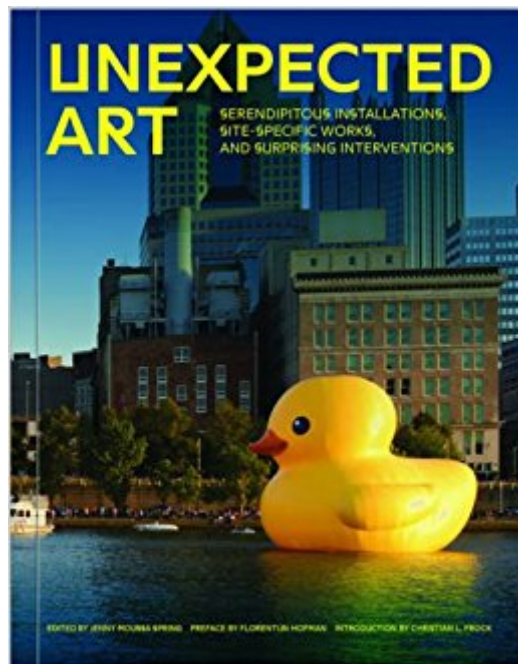




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Unexpected Art: Serendipitous Installations, Site-Specific Works, And Surprising Interventions
