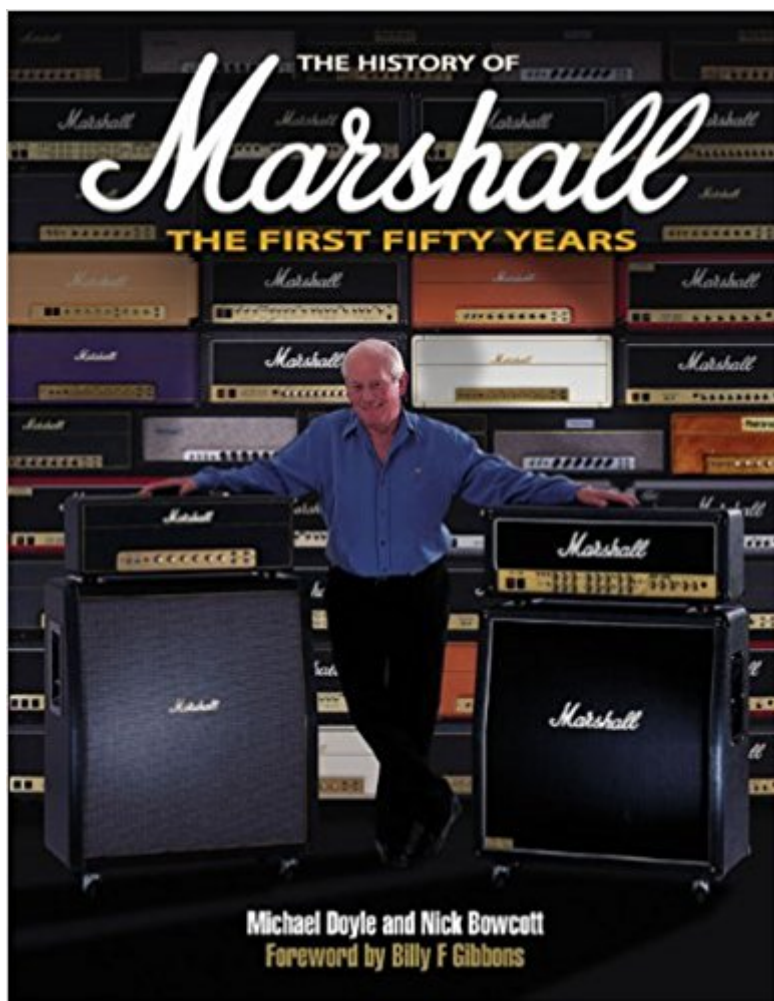

Michael Doyle and Nick Bowcott have done a wonderful job of updating Doyle's 1993 version. It is missing the technical reference material and schematics of the previous edition (I suggest getting both) but it is an excellent read. I wish the authors could have gone in to greater depth with 1970's JMP era's 1959, 1987 and Master Volume models especially considering how many classic Rock songs were recorded with them. I still love the book and give it high marks.
