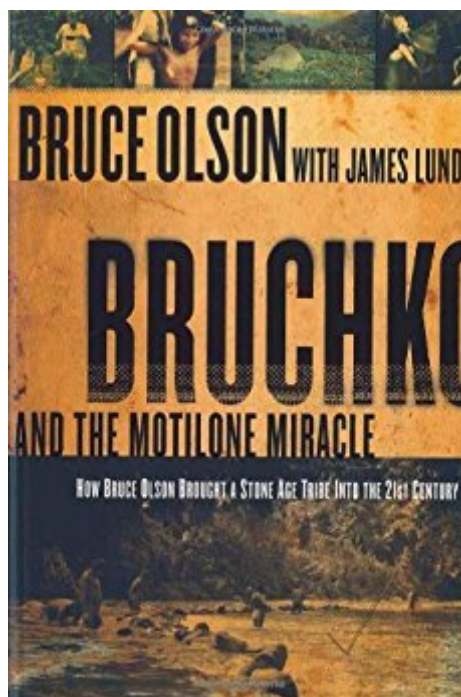




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Bruchko And The Motilone Miracle: How Bruce Olson Brought A Stone Age South American Tribe Into The 21st Century
