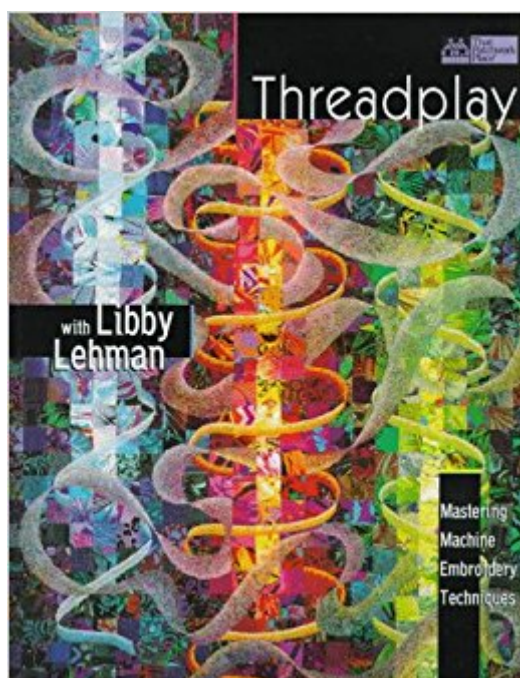

She has taught extensively in the United States as well as in Australia, New Zealand, Japan, Germany, and Switzerland. My copy, from Auntie M's Booksale on market place answers all the questions regarding threads, stabilizers, type of hoops and needles, and best of all, has beautiful photos to add to the words and demonstrate techniques of applique, the full story for quilting and finishing. the wee small hours, just to try to do them for myself. Libby says that her 'dream is forevery thread player to need a second copy because their first one is completely worn out.'
